

NOTICE INVITING BIDS

Fallbrook Public Utility District – Main Parking Area & Equipment Yard
Rehabilitation Project
Job No. 3111-PARK

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The Fallbrook Public Utility District (“District”) will receive sealed bids for the Main Parking Area & Equipment Yard Rehabilitation Project, Job No. 3111-PARK, at Fallbrook Public Utility District, 990 E. Mission Road, Fallbrook, CA 92028 no later than Wednesday, March 4th, 2020, at which time or thereafter said bids will be opened and read aloud. Bids received after this time will be returned unopened. Bids shall be valid for 60 calendar days after the bid opening date.

The work consists of the following:

- All asphalt will be sealed and all parking spaces will be re-stripped. Re-stripping will also occur in the equipment yard.
- All curbing (cracks) will be repaired or replaced (if necessary).
- In the north-east corner, the v-ditch will be repaired for better drainage.
- The center of the lot will reserve 14 specially marked spaces for FPUD customers only.
- The northern-most island will add 2 concrete pads to allow staff to walk over the island without disturbing landscaping.
- The northern-most island will have 4 concrete legs removed (from middle and west sides).
- One concrete leg will be removed from the east side of the lot.
- The southern-most island will have repairs done to sidewalk.
- The east lot entrance will add curbing to match the rest of the entry-way.
- The entire main sidewalk along the south side of the parking lot will be repaired as-needed.
- Handicap spaces will be moved in order to accommodate ADA grading requirements.
- The handicap spaces will have new signage.
- The handicap spaces will have elevated ramps removed and replaced with cut-in ramps.
- Two bollards near the gate entry pedestal will be removed.
- Motorcycle parking will be added in the southwest corner of the lot.

Bids must be submitted on District’s Bid Forms. Bidders can obtain an electronic copy of the Contract Documents by contacting the District through the contact information provided below. Electronic copies of project documents will also be made available for no cost at the District’s office at 990 E. Mission Road, Fallbrook, CA 92028. District will also make the Contract Documents available for review at its main desk. Addenda and other notices will be posted on www.fpud.com and distributed to those parties who have been issued Contract Documents.

A mandatory Pre-Bid Job Walk will be held at the Fallbrook Public Utility District main parking area at 990 E. Mission Road, Fallbrook, CA 92028, on the following date(s) and time(s): **Tuesday, February 11th, 2020, at 10am PST**. Each and every Bidder **MUST** attend the Pre-Bid Job Walk. Prospective bidders MAY NOT visit the Project Site without making arrangements through the Purchasing Department. Bids WILL NOT be accepted from any bidder who did not attend the Pre-Bid Job Walk.

The successful bidder must submit a Performance Bond equal to 100% of the contract price prior to execution of the Contract. Also, if a contract awarded to the successful bidder will exceed \$25,000, a Payment Bond equal to 100% of the contract price must also be submitted to the District prior to execution of the Contract. All bonds are to be secured from a surety that meets all of the State of California bonding requirements, as defined in Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120, and is admitted by the State of California. Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 22300, the successful bidder may substitute certain securities for funds withheld by District to ensure his performance under the Contract.

The Director of Industrial Relations has determined the general prevailing rate of per diem wages in the locality in which this work is to be performed for each craft or type of worker needed to execute the Contract which will be awarded to the successful bidder, copies of which are on file and will be made available to any interested party upon request at FPUD Office at 990 E. Mission Road, Fallbrook, CA 92028 or online at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/dlsr>. The successful bidder and all subcontractor(s) under him, shall comply with all applicable Labor Code provisions, which include, but are not limited to the payment of not less than the required prevailing rates to all workers employed by them in the execution of the Contract, the employment of apprentices, the hours of labor and the debarment of contractors and subcontractors.

Pursuant to Labor Code sections 1725.5 and 1771.1, all contractors and subcontractors that wish to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, or enter into a contract to perform public work must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations. No bid will be accepted nor any contract entered into without proof of the contractor's and subcontractors' current registration with the Department of Industrial Relations to perform public work. If awarded a Contract, the bidder and its subcontractors, of any tier, shall maintain active registration with the Department of Industrial Relations for the duration of the Project. This Project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations. In bidding on this project, it shall be the bidder's sole responsibility to evaluate and include the cost of complying with all labor compliance requirements under this Contract and applicable law in its bid.

Each bidder shall be a licensed contractor pursuant to the Business and Professions Code and shall be licensed in the following appropriate classification(s) of contractor's license(s), for the work bid upon, and must maintain the license(s) throughout the duration of the Contract: Class A General, C12, C8.

Award of Contract: District shall award the Contract for the Project to the lowest responsible bidder as determined from the base bid alone by District. District reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bids or in the bidding process.
